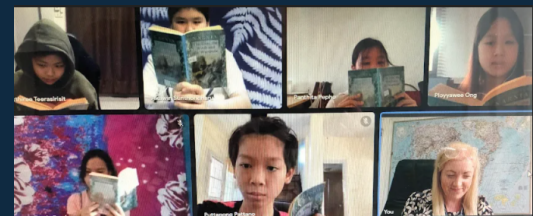
KG2

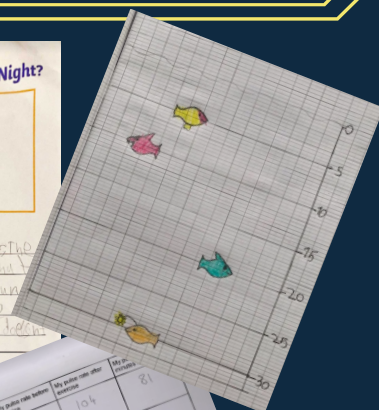
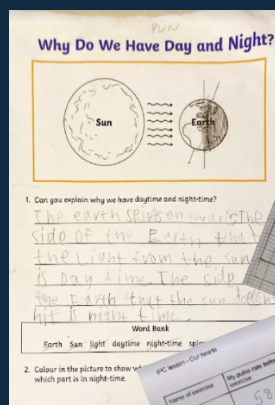
Year 9 Art Work
