School Fees for the 2023-2024 Academic Year

New Parents

Application Fee: 5,000 THB

The application fee is payable prior to taking the Discovery Day Assessment and is nonrefundable.

Discovery Fee: 5,000 THB for 3 Days

Discovery period or trial period is provided for 3 days for the students to try study and spend time in the school as per the regular routine. The fee includes a snack at breaktime and lunch.

Admission Fee: 80,000 THB

The admission fee is per one family. It is payable by new entrants to the school only

Tuition Fees and Fee Structure

Tuition Fees are invoiced three times a year and are payable before the start of every school term.

To reflect the different term lengths, the tuition fees have been divided as follows;

Tuition Fee

International curriculum delivered by fully qualified teachers.

* Extra Curricular Activities (ECA's)

Three Extra curricular activity (ECA) sessions per week is included in the fee. ECA's are conducted from 2.45 p.m. to 3.30 p.m. on Tuesday to Thursday. Attendance to clubs is compulsory as it is an important part of our curriculum. Should students sign up for swimming or premium clubs offered by an external provider then an additional cost will occur.

Internet Resources and Online Testing

This has been included into the fee and is applied across the school for all students to benefit from learning and assessment resources such as Google Suite (Meet, Classroom etc.), Tapestry, Incas Test, White Rose Maths, TT Rock Stars, MyiMaths, Read Theory, Read Works and Quick schools our student management platform.

Parent Club Fee

This is used to help with whole school events which the parent club coordinates and organizes throughout the school year.

** Examination fee for Year 10 and 11 (IGCSES)

Students in year 10 and 11 study IGCSE's with the Cambridge examination board which is a worldwide qualification. Students are expected to complete 5 examinations at the end of year 11. To assist you with payment and to ensure you are not given a large bill at the end of the year we have spread the payments across the two years in which they study. If your child wishes to take more than 5 IGCSE examinations, then additional costs will apply. Each subject has a different price scale therefore should your child choose a subject that is more expensive than what we have estimated an additional cost may occur.

** Examination fee for Year 12 and 13 (A-Levels)

Students in year 12 and 13 study A 'Levels with the Cambridge examination board which is a worldwide qualification. Students are expected to complete 2 examinations at the end of year 13 (some may take place in year 12). To assist you with payment and to ensure you are not given a large bill at the end of the year we have spread the payments across the two years in which they study. If your child wishes to take more than 2 A 'Level examinations, then additional costs will apply. Each subject has a different price scale – should your child choose a subject that is more expensive than what we have estimated an additional cost may occur.

Lunch / Snack Fee:

7,000 THB per term for Early Year 9,000 THB per term for Primary and Secondary

Students are provided with a snack and milk during the morning break and a variety of Thai and western food is provided for lunch. Students in Pre-Kindergarten, KGI - KG2 are also provided with afternoon milk.

Additional Costs

EAL Fee: 10,000 THB per term

For students in Years 1-9 whose English assessments show that they require English as an Additional Language (EAL) support.

Year 6 End of Year Examinations:

Students in Year 6 complete end of Year SAT exams in English, Maths and Science. Fees change yearly so parents will be billed for these examinations separately.

Additional Information

A discount of 2% will be given if you make a full annual fee payment at the start of the academic year.

We also offer a sibling discount. If you enroll a second child into the school we offer a 10% discount for the family.
